During the transitional phase from FP7 ACTRIS to H2020 ACTRIS-2, the former website www.actris.eu has served as joint web portal for both projects until implementation of the new website. Thus, the ACTRIS web portal has been available since project start on May 1, 2015. A preliminary new web portal has been jointly implemented by CNRS and NILU and is operational since M2 (June 2015) under <a href="http://actris2.nilu.no/">http://actris2.nilu.no/</a>, cf. Figure 1. This temporary location will be moved shortly to host the ACTRIS web portal at <a href="http://actris.eu">www.actris.eu</a>.

The new ACTRIS web portal is the central access point to the ACTRIS Research Infrastructure for the observation of aerosols, clouds, and trace gases. It represents, thus, not only the integrated activity ACTRIS-2 but the overall RI and its efforts towards a coherent, sustainable observation service across Europe.


The ACTRIS web portal provides the first source of information to the environmental research communities, stake holders, policy makers, industry and private sector, general public and allows accessing the key elements supporting the research infrastructure: observing station and exploratory platforms, instrument calibration centres, the data centre. It further informs about the status and ongoing activities of the different projects: ACTRIS towards ESFRI roadmap and ACTRIS-2 (including access to the former FP7 ACTRIS web site) including objectives, progress, and results.

The ACTRIS web portal publishes and advertises the opportunities for transnational access available under ACTRIS-2 (TNA to calibration centres and observations facilities) and provides access to the data centre, project results, publication, documentation material, or any other project-specific information pertinent to project partners, the scientific community, SMEs, etc.

A login-based intranet is used as tool for exchanging information and accessing internal documents under the ACTRIS projects. Access to selected pages or documents is, thus, restricted and depends on the level of access (depending on user type).

The ACTRIS web portal is officially hosted by partner NILU, and managed by CNRS and CNR. It is continuously updated. The maintenance of ACTRIS-2 is the responsibility of CNRS, content management for the ACTRIS RI is under the lead of FMI.
